



COURT MAINTENANCE

General Remarks

The longevity and aesthetic quality of Resitop Systems is to a large part, dependent upon its application to a properly constructed, cured and cleansed base supporting a smooth, dense surface with adequate drainage. Any areas that hold water in a depth greater than a nickel or a euro shall be patched. Coloured surface must be uniform 10m out of the court with the sun in the back.

Maintenance

Resitop Systems need very low maintenance.

Use adequate sport footwear.

Keep the court free of sand and foreign matter to prevent premature deterioration.

Clean from time to time your court. Use adequate pressure washing with water to remove dirt, mildew and debris from the surface and dry using a power blower. Check for birdbaths and low spots.

Place under chairs or heavy objects pads to avoid surface deterioration.

Do not drive equipment onto the court without protecting.
